

# Andrew Michael Barker

Andrew began his working career as an officer in the Royal Air Force Administrative Branch where he held appointments in HR, Finance, Training and Facilities and Estates Management. He left the Royal Air Force in the rank of Squadron Leader to commence a career in Facilities Management at the inception of the industry in the UK in 1992.

His first Facilities Management appointment was as an Account Manager for Procord, the MBO of IBM's Property Department where he was a part of the team that took Procord from a 92 to 2,000 staff company in 4 years, with year-on-year average growth of 58.5%, at which time it was acquired by Johnson Controls UK. He was also a Member of the CBI Competing for Quality and PFI Advisory Groups.

Andrew joined Haden MacLellan Holdings in the UK in 1996 to help to form MacLellan International. He secured various new business appointments including the Ford India plant in Chennai, India and was subsequently appointed as Vice President Operations MacLellan India. In 1999, Andrew submitted the Ford/MacLellan contract for, and won, the UK Premises and Facilities Management Partnership Award. He returned to the UK in late 1999 as Sales & Marketing Director on the Board.

He returned to India in 2000 to take up appointment as the National Director for Corporate Property Services for Jones Lang LaSalle where he helped to establish their India FM business and to begin to grow their regional FM business throughout Asia. Andrew moved to Hong Kong as Regional Accounts Director. In 2002, Andrew was appointed as Regional Director Asset Services for Cushman & Wakefield where he helped to establish their regional FM business taking the business start-up to 16 contracts across 14 countries in Asia Pacific in 2 years. In 2004, Andrew was asked to re-join Jones Lang LaSalle in India to continue to grow the business he commenced in 2000.

With the rapid development of the Middle East market, Andrew joined the Board of Serco Middle East in March 2006 as Operations Director providing FM services to Dubai World and 26 other customers in Dubai where he was Director of Serco Innovation and General Manager for Serco Gulf. In 2007 Andrew returned to Singapore as Regional Head of Property & Facilities Management Services for ABN AMRO Bank where he held responsibility for all Real Estate activity across Asia and the Middle East.

He has recently been appointed as CEO of the newly-formed Tenon Property Services seeking to help organisations to achieve "real cost, quality and sustainability efficiencies" through Property, Facilities and Projects service integration and delivery.

Andrew holds a MSc in FM and a MBA from Cranfield School of Management in the UK. He has been an active Member of CoreNet since 2000 participating as a member of the Asia Summit Planning Committees. He has recently been appointed to the Asia Regional Council as Vice-Chair Learning and is a member of the Faculty for the Asia EDP programme.

He continues to live in Singapore with his wife and 2 children and enjoys scuba diving, yoga and running.
